

Step by step guide to Uploading Resources.



1 Title: Enter Title Here
This is the name by which your resource will be known, and its version (such as 1.0).

2 Tag Line:
Provide a very brief, one-line description of your resource.

Resource Type: Uploaded file:

3 Price:

Description:

4 Provide a more in-depth description of your resource, including its feature highlights and any other important information. You should also include installation instructions in this area, if any are required.

Additional Information URL:
If you have your own web page containing a demo, extended description or support services etc. for this resource, enter its URL here.

5 Upload resource icon
If you have an icon to upload for this resource, you will be given an option to upload this icon after saving. This icon should be 96x96 pixels.

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1*: The prefix is where you can select who your resource is for (Age, e.g. Year 1)
Insert your title
(Your resource name e.g. Maths Planning Data)
Tip: Think about what a teacher might type into a search engine like Google to find a product like yours.

2*: TAG line: a bit more information to help those downloading.

3*: Resource Type, are you selling or sharing.
If you're uploading a free resource, leave the price box unchecked.
Sellers: Pricing a product is a complex task. Be reasonable but don't undervalue your work.

4*: **Add a description.**
Search results are tied to product titles and descriptions. Include relevant keywords and phrases as well as your store name in your description.
Describe your product and how to use it thoroughly. Check your spelling. Look for typos.

5: [OPTIONAL]
Additional Information URL.
This can be a link to your blog or website where you support your resource.

6: Upload resource icon, this is a small icon that will be shown on the resources menu. It is required for your resource to be featured.

7*: Upload images; Add a short sample of your product free or paid. **8***: Save.
